OLD BUSINESS

Danny Lowe reported that CPW met with the contractor for the Cedar Creek/Club Drive project concerning the depth of the pipe installed on December 17th. Richard Berry with Tri-Star has agreed to pull elevation levels and anywhere there is not a storm drain or other reason so go deeper, they would reinstall the pipe to the correct level underground. Mr. Lowe stated that the change order for the Long Shadow Dr. project has been approved and 190 days added for this project.

Mr. Lowe reported the roof has been repaired at the Dry Branch Well and we are still waiting for the electrical switch to come in, it has been ordered.

Danny stated that all main lines have been installed in Oak Hill and has been pressure tested. Mr. Lowe reported that the altitude valve has been approved. Tank drawings have been received and presented to

the Commissioners. Danny stated there was a little issue with Aiken County with the driveways in Oak Hill but it has been resolved. Danny said the tank should be going out for bid at the beginning of the year.

Danny Lowe reported that the property on Milestone Circle has been sold.

Mr. Lowe stated he received another bid for re-paving the bad spots of the road on Florida Ave. and Fern St. After discussion, it was voted on and approved to go with Carolina Construction.

Ken Phillips gave an update of field activities for October.
